# INTERNATIONAL BENCHMARK TEST

#### **Enhancing Literacy and Numeracy**

DLF CARES has partnered with ACER to conduct the International Benchmark Test (IBT). Over the last two years, the focus has been on assessing foundational learning in English, Maths, Science, and Reasoning among students in classes 3 to 8 across 20 states. The assessment helps identify learning gaps and subsequently guides targeted interventions to improve learning outcomes. It also adds value by identifying students who meet international benchmark standards, enabling the upgrading of scholars into high quality schools. The IBT continues to be a valuable tool in driving academic excellence and shaping brighter futures.








#### Annual Extravaganza
